** The processor assessment is an obligation under the Fluid Milk Promotion Order (7 CFR § 1160.101 <u>et seq.</u>). The Order requires that all persons who process and market commercially more than 3,000,000 pounds of fluid milk products in consumer-type packages in the 48 contiguous States and the District of Columbia on a monthly basis, excluding those fluid milk products delivered to the residence of a consumer, be assessed 20 cents per hundredweight on all marketings of such packaged fluid milk products during the month.

1/ On October 12, 2005, the U.S. Department of Agriculture announced a final rule that amends § 1005.81 of the Appalachian Federal Milk Marketing Order. Effective November 1, 2005, the transportation credit for the Appalachian Marketing Area will increase from \$0.065 per hundredweight to \$0.095 per hundredweight.
