SUBJECT: Expiration of Dairy Forward Pricing Program

Many programs and policies of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) were authorized under the Agriculture Act of 2014 (2014 Farm Bill) through September 30, 2018. Beginning October 1, 2018, the authority or funding provided under the 2014 Farm Bill for USDA to operate a number of these programs, including the Dairy Forward Pricing Program expired. As of October 1, 2018, Congress has not passed a 2018 Farm Bill or other legislation extending the authority for USDA to carry out this program, and USDA cannot make new commitments to the program.

Therefore, proprietary handlers establishing **new** forward contracts on or after October 1, 2018, will not be exempt from paying minimum Federal order prices. Previously established contracts that extend through September 30, 2021, are not impacted.
