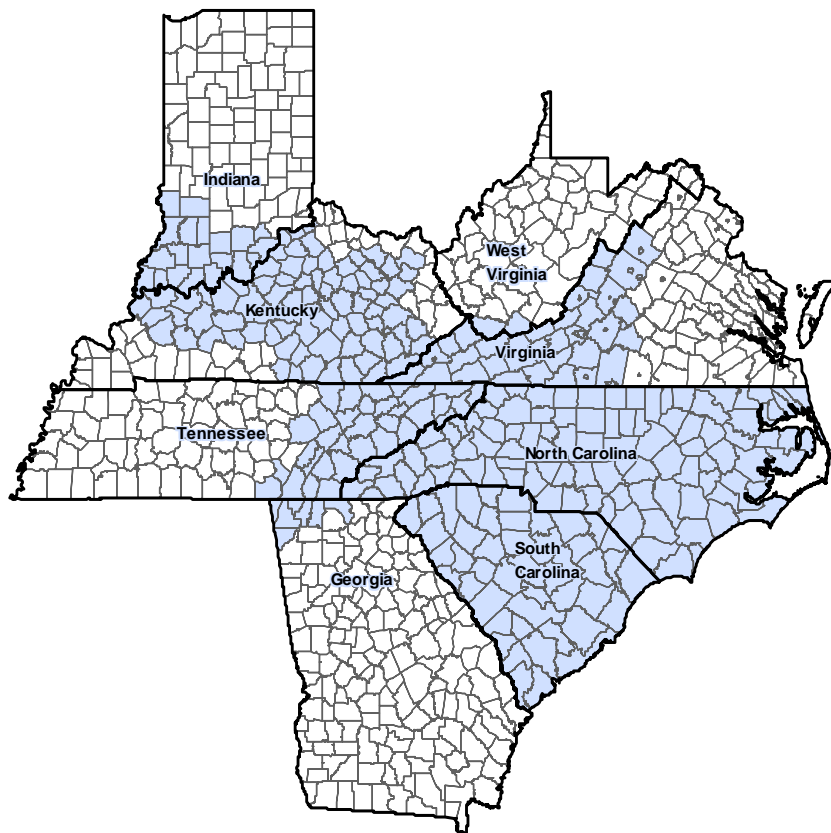

Figure 1 **Map - Pool Distributing Plants - December 2014**

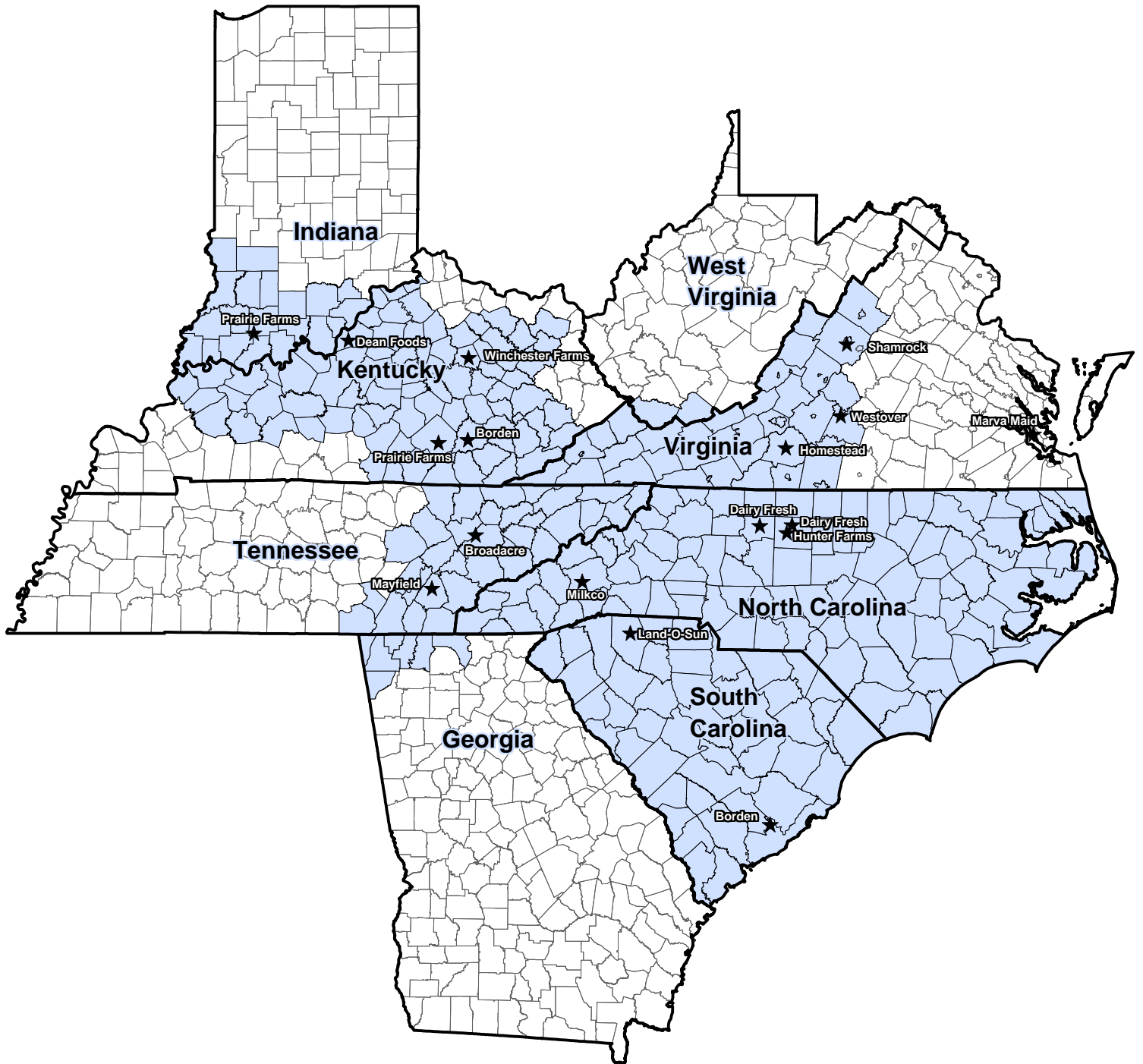

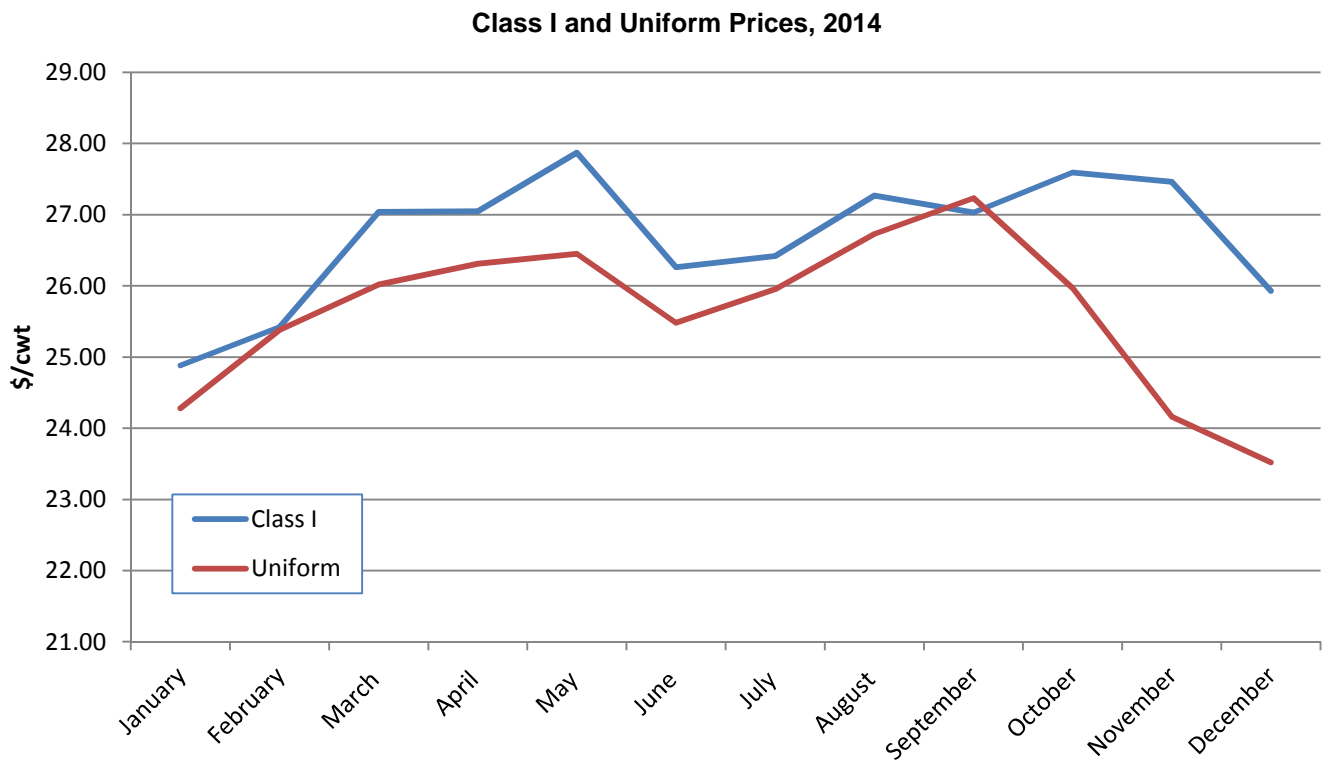
